

Assembly Instructions for Lyndhurst Bistro Table

(2019 Design)

Parts Included	
Item	Quantity
Tabletop	1
Legs	2
Dowels	8-10 (8 are required)
Screws	4-6 (4 are required)
Metal Parasol Ring and Cover	1

If you discover any of the stated parts are missing or damaged, please contact Field & Hawken customer support immediately for it to be rectified and replacements provided if required.

Screwdriver (not provided)	1	Small saw (not provided)	1
Small hammer (not provided)	1	Sandpaper (medium and fine grade)	1

Recommended Persons for Assembly
It is possible to assemble this table with 1 person but please take care when turning the table upright.

Assembly Instructions

1. Lay the tabletop face down on some padding or protective material (Picture A).
2. Assemble the 2 leg components to the tabletop by matching the small numbered stickered joints (E.g. A1 to A1, A2 to A2, etc.), as shown in Pictures B.
3. Tap in the dowels using the small hammer to secure the legs in place. Ensure that close contact is maintained between the leg section and the tabletop underside. The dowels should go in 2/3rds to their full length to provide a secure fix. If there is any excess dowel, then a small saw can be used to reduce the excess before sanding.
4. Insert the screws into the predrilled holes in the legs support bars that run between the legs and screw into the tabletop (Picture C).
5. Using a medium sandpaper grade (E.g. 80), reduce any remaining excess dowel before using a fine sandpaper grade (E.g. 120-180) to finish. Ensure that you only smooth a little off the surface of the teak to maintain a consistent colouration.
6. Place the metal parasol ring and cover in the centre hole of the table.
7. Enjoy
